

Service Requirements & Frequently Asked Questions:

- **How many hours do I need to complete?**

15 Hours per year. Students may begin completing their service hours during the summer before the upcoming school year.

- **When are my service hours due?**

All hours are due April 1st of the spring semester.

- **Do I need to differentiate between Gold and Red hours?**

No. Fenwick no longer requires service hours to be differentiated between Gold and Red hours. Your service can be direct or indirect service.

- **Can I volunteer to help my family or a neighbor?**

Not for these requirements. Helping a family member or neighbor is a basic responsibility of being part of a family and a community. We ask that students go beyond these normal duties to broaden their perspective and experience. Service must be completed through a legitimate non-profit church, school, or other charitable organization.

- **If I have to do a service activity for NHS, KEY Club, Student Ambassadors or other school commitment, does it count for my school hours, too?**

No. You may not “double dip” with regards to service hours. If a service project is required for another club or organization, that project cannot count towards your personal community service requirement.

- **How do I log in my hours?**

Go to www.x2vol.com to log in and to get a tutorial.

- **How long should my service reflection be?**

Your service reflection should be about 2-3 sentences long for *each* question, resulting in a short paragraph about your service experience.
